

Harris County is piloting a new, community-driven network approach to supporting quality improvement in early learning settings (primarily focused on child care settings). The goal of the Early Learning Quality Network (ELQN) is to improve local community child care quality through community-led planning and community-directed funding. ELQN's strategic goal is to improve early learning and care by working alongside providers, families, and other community stakeholders to focus on quality improvement initiatives that build upon the unique strengths and opportunities of each focal community.

ELQN is working towards:

- 2,500+ children across Harris County to experience improved child care environments;
- Families to have increased access to quality child care that meets their needs and preferences;
- Additional community infrastructure to support quality child care in Harris County.

- Collaboratively develop a Child Care
  Quality Action Plan with the community
  that articulates the vision and strategies
  to improve quality in early learning and
  care settings
- Support and monitor implementation of Child Care Quality Action Plan with the community
