- **This position will report to the Director of Media Activism.**

General Responsibilities and Essential Functions:

- **Marketing and Editing:** Experienced with Canva and able to produce visually appealing products in a fast-paced environment; **experienced with video and audio editing.**
- **Logistics and Coordination:** Ability to work cross functionally to support all external partner scheduling needs and coordinate necessary logistics for virtual and in person events/functions that may involve media and/or community audiences.
- **Facilitate Radio Program:** Coordinate all Amplified Houston guest engagement, including pre- and post-show outreach. Attend all Amplified Houston live episodes. Coordinate show descriptions for KPFT to ensure they have the information they need to promote the show. Ability to step-in as a show host as needed.
- **Community Engagement:** Must be comfortable with public engagement and speaking with key stakeholders, including funders, elected officials, community leaders, and nonprofit colleagues, to ensure collaboration and project success.
- **Communication:** A strong communicator that documents projects, tasks, and follows up with all involved entities. Intellectually curious and driven with great overcommunication practices.
